Laurence Caviezel studied medicine in Geneva and obtained her federal medical diploma in 2000. She then began her post-graduate training in the canton of Fribourg in general surgery (Hôpital Sud Fribourgeois, Riaz) and internal medicine (Hôpital cantonal de Fribourg). Returning to Geneva in 2002, she began her specialist training in anaesthesiology at Geneva University Hospitals (HUG) in Professor F. Clergue's department.
