Competences

Pre-operative and post-operative endoscopic diagnostics and therapy

(approx. 1000 bariatric patients per year)

Gastroscopy including

- Treatment of tumour-postoperative stenoses by balloon dilatation or stenting
- Sclerotherapy for gastric bypass patients with post-operative secondary weight gain or dumping syndrome
- Endoscopic gastric band removal for band penetration
- Gastro-gastric fistula closure
- Placement and removal of gastric balloons

Double balloon enteroscopy

Assessment and treatment of inflammatory or neoplastic or chronic bleeding in the entire small intestine. In patients who have undergone gastric bypass surgery: assessment and treatment of the stomach - including gastric bleeding - as well as visualisation and treatment of biliodigestive anastomosis.

Capsule enteroscopy

Diagnostic clarification of the small intestine - mainly for bleeding, chronic inflammation and neoplasia.

Colonoscopy

Colon cancer screening, polypectomies, haemostasis, dilatation of stenoses, stent placement, diagnosis and treatment of chronic inflammatory bowel diseases (Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, lymphocytic colitis, collagenous colitis, intestinal spirochetosis).

Proctoscopy

Diagnosis and treatment of anal fissures, haemorrhoids, incontinence investigations, clarification of anal itching, removal of mariscus, treatment of genital warts

Hepatology

Diagnosis and treatment of liver diseases (hepatitis A, B, C, D, E; autoimmune liver diseases, primary sclerosing cholangitis, primary biliary cirrhosis, Wilson's disease, haemochromatosis, alpha 1 fetoprotein deficiency)

Nutritional medicine

Clarification of food intolerances such as lactose, fructose, histamine, gluten and sorbitol intolerance in close co-operation with various specialists.
