KNEE JOINT

Cartilage/meniscus lesions, early degenerative changes

- Microfractures, AMIC (autologous matrix-induced chondrogenesis), minced cartilage repair
- Arthroscopically assisted partial meniscectomy and/or meniscal suturing
- Corrective osteotomies, usually in combination with one of the above procedures

Arthrosis

- Minimally invasive implantation of knee prostheses (medial, lateral and patellofemoral)
- Total knee replacement

Painful knee prostheses

- Tailored assessment of pain following implantation of knee prostheses
- Complex revision operations and replacement of knee prostheses

Sports injuries

- Arthroscopic reconstruction of cruciate ligaments
- Suturing and/or partial resection of the meniscus
- Minimally invasive suturing or reconstructions of collateral ligaments
- Operations on patellofemoral instability
